WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 **District Institute of Education and Training, Paschim Medinipur, Vill-Jhargram, Tehsil/Taluka-Jangalkhas, Town/City/P.O-Jhargram, Dist-Midnapore, West Bengal-721507** has submitted an application (CodeNo.ERCAPP81) to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for conducting D.El.Ed. Course with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) on **dt.28.10.2009**.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution. the documents attached therewith, the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Elementary Teacher Education Programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **District Institute of Education and Training, Paschim Medinipur, Vill-Jhargram, Tehsil/Taluka-Jangalkhas, Town/City/P.O-Jhargram, Dist-Midnapore, West Bengal-721507** has submitted an application for conducting **D.El.Ed. Course of Elementary (level) of two years** duration with an annual intake of **50 (fifty)** from the academic session **2012-2013** under clause 7(11) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2009.

- (v) The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (vi) The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:-
- Copy of the Application Form
  - Land and Building Particulars
  - Staff Profile
  - Recognition letter
  - Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

5. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

6. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi-110002 against this order under Section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. **WHEREAS**, in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993, District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Plot No.-2373, St. No.-9, Vill/Po-Jhargram, Tehsil/Taluka-Jhangalkhas, Town/City-Jhargram, Dist-Midmnapore, West Bengal - 721507 (**Code No.-ERCAPP2142**) has applied for grant of permission for **D.El.Ed. (Addl. Intake) Course** online on **25-03-2015** for two year duration and hard copy received by Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE on **10-04-2015**.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the affiliating body, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

3. **NOW THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants permission to District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Plot No.-2373, St. No.-9, Vill/Po-Jhargram, Tehsil/Taluka-Jhangalkhas, Town/City-Jhargram, Dist-Midmnapore, West Bengal- 721507 for conducting **D.El.Ed. (Addl. Intake) Course** of two years duration **with an additional intake of 50 students, (existing 50 intake + additional 50 intake), thus making the total intake of 100 (One hundred)** from the academic session **2017-2018** under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- II. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- III. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position 15, Neelakantha Nagar, Nayapalli, Bhubaneswar (ODISHA) - 751 012

Further, the recognition/permission is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. The institution shall maintain its website with hyperlink to the Council and the Eastern Regional Committee, covering, inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake; availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms and other facilities or amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website, namely:-

- a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
- b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
- c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter;
- d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
- e) Fee charged from students;
- f) Available infrastructural facilities;
- g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to, and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on its website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

7. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

8. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.

9. The Educational institution shall follow Uniform Accounting System as brought out by ICAI and accepted by MHRD.


